



Abellon wins Golden Peacock Award 2011

Under the category of Eco-innovation for Eco-Chulha



Eco-chulha, our eco-friendly cookstove, has won the prestigious "Golden Peacock Eco-innovation Award for the year 2011", organized by the New Delhi-based Institute of Directors (IOD).

The awards are scrutinized by a jury of 40 members, including four former chief justices, at least 15 senior officers belonging to the Indian Administrative Service, apart from two former Prime Ministers, Joe Clark of Canada and Ola Ullsten of Sweden. India's leading businessmen and politicians have routinely attended the awards felicitating events.

Selected by the Jury under the Chairmanship of Justice P N Bhagwati (Former Chief Justice of India and Member, UN Human Rights Commission), the award was presented to Abellon by Hon'ble K V Thomas, Union Minister of State for Food and Consumer Affairs, at the Awards Presentation Ceremony held in New Delhi on 25 June 2011.
